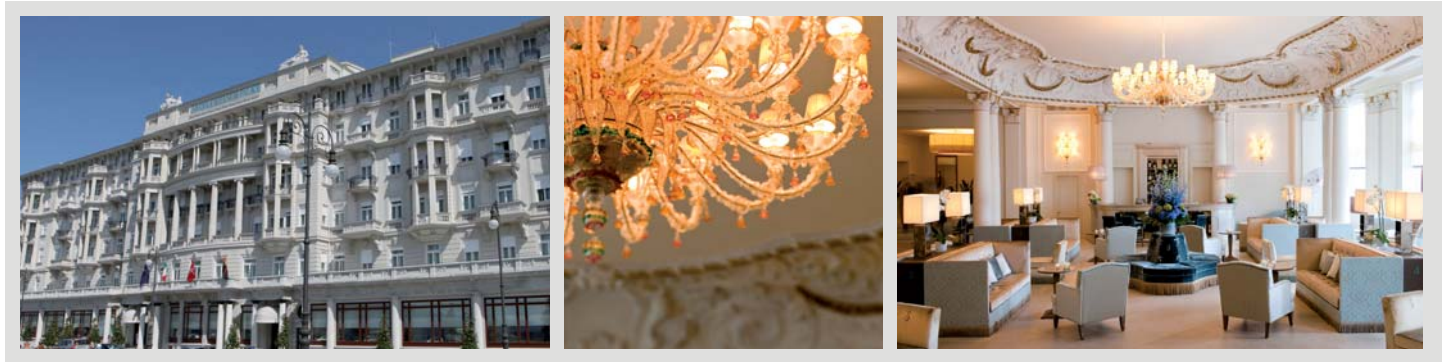


# Savoia Excelsior Palace

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## classical building and artistic interiors

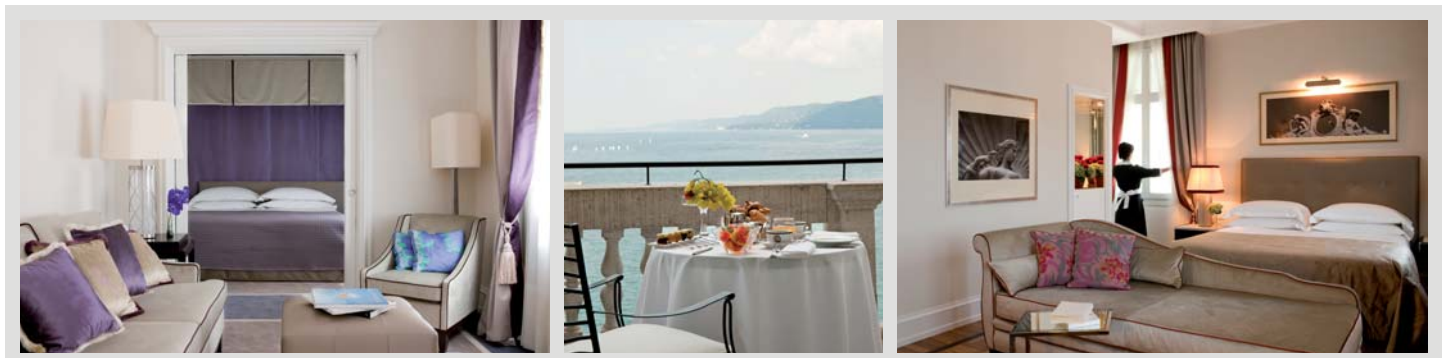
The Savoia Excelsior Palace has been totally renovated and restored to the grandeur of its original form though featuring today's modern conveniences. Inside, the walls have been fitted with a *boiserie* whose classical design and finish exudes a warm and welcoming atmosphere of Mitteleuropean interiors. The atmosphere reverberates with the unparalleled sense of luxury of a turn-of-the-century Grand Hotel.

## history

The Savoia Excelsior Palace is a historic building, designed by the Austrian architect Ladislaus Fiedler. It was first opened in 1912, soon to be reputed "the most imposing and luxurious hotel in Austro-Hungary". The *facade* is decorated with sculptures and columns; its wide balconies overlook the Gulf of Trieste and afford a breathtaking view of the port and the Castello di Miramare.

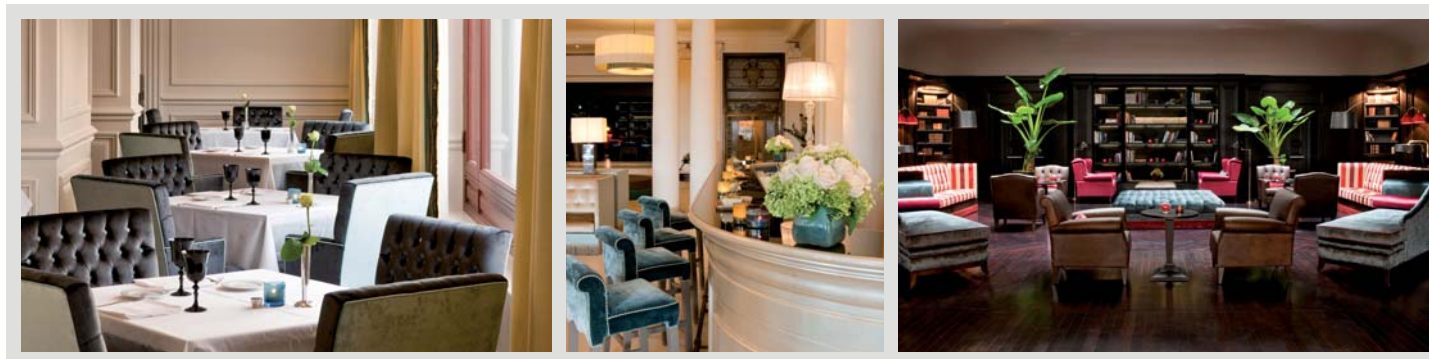

## rooms & suites

The 142 rooms and suites are decorated in a classical style to which a dash of contemporary taste has been artfully added. Sumptuous, elegant fabrics such as leather and silk, Calacatta marble in the bathrooms and pastel wallpaper set the tone. Care has been taken over the minute detail, from the monogrammed cushions to the bolsters and the matching tassels and fringes. The spacious terraces overlooking the gulf are furnished with sea-view breakfasts in mind. The Cruise Suite is a large 106 sqm (1200 sqf) apartment, decorated in nautical style, in the manner of the master cabin of a large yacht.



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## bar & restaurant

The lobby area houses the “Savoy Lounge” Bar and the “Savoy” Restaurant, situated on the waterfront side of the hotel. With its majestic shell-shaped ceiling, the “Savoy Lounge” Bar is one of the city’s prestigious meeting spots. Large windows afford a view of the Gulf of Trieste that is beyond compare. The restaurant seats up to 150 people.

## relaxation

A large nineteenth-century pavilion style skylight fills the winter garden with natural light. This area also serves as the hotel library. Opening soon on the top floor: a sea-view wellness centre with swimming pool.



## meetings & incentives

The conference centre boasts 9 meeting rooms and can hold up to 650 people with a maximum capacity of 320 people in the largest meeting room. The meeting rooms have undergone restoration work on the frescoes, the lighting systems and the *boiseries*. The centre benefits from natural light and a magnificent view.
